### **June – National Microchipping Month!**

Due to new legislation coming into force on 1 July 2009, when applying for a passport your horse now needs to have a microchip implanted as well.

Microchipping is a simple almost painless procedure.

Once microchipped, your horse will carry its own unique chip number for life. This number together with your details will be registered in the national PetLog database. The chip number should also be recorded in your horse's passport.

Microchipping greatly increases the chances of you becoming re-united with your horse should they ever stray or get stolen. Many horses have very similar whorls and markings, therefore making it easier for the police, RSPCA and vets to confirm the identity of an unknown animal by simply searching for a microchip.

**So, aside from legislation, microchipping offers peace of mind by being a cost effective way of permanently linking your horse to you!**
